

The Westport River Watershed Alliance provides week-long, science programs along the Westport River for children ages 5-16 years. Thanks to the Gay Gillespie Scholarship Fund, we are able to offer full and partial scholarships to families who reside in the towns that make up the Westport River Watershed including:

Westport, Dartmouth, Fall River, and Freetown in MA Tiverton and Little Compton in RI

Scholarships are provided on a first come, first serve basis while funding is available. To qualify for financial-based scholarships, families must make 80% or less than the *state median income range. Families who make 60% or less will automatically qualify for full scholarships.
